## MyEd Update

We are aware that some parents have contacted us with questions about the MyEd app, specifically the issue of students not yet being activated on parent accounts. We are doing everything we can to address this issue, including posting a contact information form to the home of each student, which when completed and returned will allow us to update our system. This should then automatically activate your child's details on your app.

We hope you will appreciate that when moving from a long-established system to a new one, there will be teething problems at the start, which we hope to resolve as soon as possible. We will keep you posted on this issue.

The app is available for both Apple iOS and Android devices. If you do not have either of these systems and so cannot download the app, you will still receive text messages and emails from Longcroft, meaning you won't miss out on information we circulate.
