Understanding our Uniform

INTRODUCTION

The aim of this booklet is to illustrate what to do and what not to do in terms of the Longcroft School Uniform.

Following on from consultation with governors, parents and students, the majority view was to remove the green polo-shirt uniform option and move towards all students wearing shirt and tie.

The results also showed a desire to have the uniform smartened up in general and creation of a new school crest, whilst at the same time reflecting Longcroft's heritage (e.g. retaining green as the school's official colour).

Occasionally we will update this booklet, with additional photographs to illustrate the levels of smartness and pride in appearance we would like students to adhere to.

SHIRT AND TIE

Plain white school shirt, long enough to tuck into your trousers, with correctly tied school tie.



The old school polo shirts and fashion shirts are not allowed.

Any tops/vests under the uniform must not be visible.



TROUSERS

Sensible, loose-fitting black trousers.



No tight trousers, leggings or jeans.



SKIRTS

Plain black skirt that must be knee-length at all times. Black tights are also permitted, but not essential.



You are in breach of our uniform rules if you wear your skirt above knee-length.



JUMPERS

The Longcroft branded jumper only.



No other black jumpers, jumpers of different colours or cardigans.



FOOTWEAR

Sensible, plain black footwear.



No trainers, logos or boots.



OUTDOOR WEAR

Suitable coats to keep you dry and warm.



No denim jackets, hoodies, tracksuits or branded tops.



Longcroft hoodies for sports, performing arts, etc. will still be available to buy, but must NOT be worn at school. They must only be used when, for example, a Longcroft team is representing the school elsewhere.

BELTS

Dark, plain belt with a simple fastening.



Fashion, studded or belts with big buckles are not allowed.



JEWELLERY

Students may wear a watch, one simple ring and one small stud in each ear if pierced.



No other items of jewelry are allowed.



MAKE-UP

Discreet make-up is allowed.



Makeup must not be obvious,
noticeable or excessive.

Coloured nail varnish is not allowed.
