

Netball Season has Successful Start



Thank you to all parents who are successfully using Show My Homework, our new online homework system.

If you are a parent of a student in Years 9 to 13 and received your pin number before summer, but have yet to sign in, please note that this code has now expired. For data protection reasons, the company re-sets pin numbers if they are unused for three months.

If you have already logged into the system and are using it, then your pin number will not be changed. However, if you have yet to log in for the first time, you will need to call school to request a new pin, which will be emailed to you.
